## TRANSPORTATION SERVICES

There will be a daily shuttle service, properly identified, offering delegates daily transportation to and from the Jamaica Conference Centre. The bus will be parked at the Pegasus Hotel, accessible to nearby properties (Courtleigh Hotel, Liguanea Club, Marriot Courtyard hotel). The rates for shuttle service are: 10 USD/1,500 JAD for round trip and 5 USD/700 JAD for a one-way trip.
