Excellencies,

I wish to refer to my letters dated 3, 6, 9, 10 and 13 November 2020, concerning the twenty-sixth session of the Assembly of the International Seabed Authority.

In my letter dated 13 November 2020, I informed that the decision entitled "Election of Vice-Presidents" was considered adopted by the Assembly, and accordingly Nigeria, Poland and the Dominican Republic have been elected as Vice-Presidents of the Assembly for its twenty-sixth session. I further informed that in view of the pending nomination, the election of the remaining Vice-President will be conducted soon after I receive information on the nomination by the Group of Asia-Pacific States.

I have the privilege of informing you that I have received, through the Secretariat, the nomination of the Republic of Nauru as Vice-President of the Assembly for the seat allocated to the Group of Asia-Pacific States.

I propose that the Republic of Nauru be elected as Vice-President of the Assembly for its twenty-sixth session.

**Accordingly, the proposal to elect the Republic of Nauru as Vice-President of the Assembly for its twenty-sixth session is placed under the silence procedure until 17:00 on Monday, 23 November 2020 (Jamaica time).**

Any objection to the above proposal should be transmitted in a letter or a note verbal addressed to me, with a clear indication of an objection being raised to the proposal.
