On 21 February, Mr. Randolph Kirchain and Mr. Richard Roth of the Massachusetts Institute of Technology (MIT) gave a presentation on a comparison of four economic models for the exploitation of polymetallic nodules in the Area. The detailed presentation on the model developed by MIT which followed included recommendations for the Authority.

During the first part of the twenty-fifth session of the Council, the Council expressed its appreciation of the work by MIT and of the progress made by the working group. In addition, the Council agreed to hold a second meeting of the working group to make further progress on the payment mechanism.
