In the event that an application for a Plan of Work is submitted for an area where no such Regional Environmental Management Plan exists, the drafting of a Regional Environmental Management Plan applicable to the area in concern shall be prioritised and adopted as soon as possible according to the best available science, without any undue delay, taking into account—Section 2, Article 15 b/c of the 1994 Implementing Agreement.]
