ICPC supports in the inclusion of text in in the Regulation 48bis proposed by Germany to address the risks of uncoordinated test mining to submarine cables. Absent modification of the Exploration Regulations to address this need for coordination with respect to test mining, the ICPC does not support treatment of test mining under the Exploration Regulations.
