Any environmental policy designed successfully to manage the good environmental status of the deep sea should be primarily based on the principle that those habitats should not suffer any significant impacts. (The same comment applies to subparagraph (b))

52(h) - It should be stated clearly how this prevention takes place. The contractor should present both a prevention and a contingency plan for the introduction of non-indigenous species. The term invasive must be avoided, since a non-indigenous species can be invasive of not. In some circumstances, a non-invasive species can show an invasive "behaviour" in one place and not in the other _______ 58 - In our view, clear statement should be made in order to apply specific resources to the development of technological solutions to monitoring. It seems that facilitate a forum on technology development is not enough. Financial resources have to be allocated. It could be up to the Authority to allocate some of the financial outcomes of the exploitation to the development of such solutions (as well as to the adoption of this management plan as a whole)
