Regulation 30

Safety, labour and health standards

- 1. The Contractor shall ensure at all times that:
 - (a) All vessels and Installations operating and engaged in Exploitation activities are in good repair, in a safe and sound condition [in accordance with the requirements, specifications and preventive or corrective maintenance plans of the respective manufacturers,] and adequately manned crewed, [display navigation lights and shapes as per Collision Regulations] and comply with paragraphs 2 and 3 below; and
 - (b) All vessels and Installations employed engaged in Exploitation activities have an appropriate class designation and shall remain in class for the duration of the exploitation contract.

5. Please indicate the rationale for the proposal. [150-word limit]

Australia suggests that sub-paragraphs (1)(a) and (b) adopt consistent language to describe relevant vessels and Installations. Currently, Regulation 30(1)(a) refers to vessels and Installations "operating and engaged in Exploitation activities", while Regulation 30(1)(b) refers to vessels and Installations "employed in Exploitation activities". Australia is not aware of there being a reason for the different terminology, and suggests it would be preferable to use consistent language for legal clarity. Australia suggests that 'engaged in Exploitation activities' would be preferable.

Australia also recommends replacing the word 'manned' with 'crewed' in sub-paragraph (1)(a).
