Purpose of the Environmental Compensation Fund

Australia supports Regulation 55(2) over 55(2 alt) referring to the 'polluter pays' principle over the 'precautionary principle'. As such, Australia supports removing the square brackets around 'polluter pays'. The matter of precaution is not an appropriate reference when considering the responsibility and distribution of the burden of costs. Australia suggests that this revision is made throughout the regulations when a full legal review for consistency in terminology and drafting is undertaken in the future.

Australia supports the Facilitator's suggestion to omit Regulation 55(3). It is unclear the value it adds to the purpose statement in Regulation 55(1).
