It is important to point out that there must be important measures to not allow requests for refunds to become a common practice. Constantly overpaying royalty and then requesting refunds could become a path for obtaining other indirect benefits, such as corporate tax reductions in contractors' home countries, or others. It would also be desirable to have both the Secretary General and the Council authorize refunds.
