We strongly support this new regulation, as a way to increase transparency about who is ultimately benefiting from mining in the Area, and as a means to combat corruption, conflict of interest, transfer pricing, and monopolization. However, we think it should also be integrated into the Regulations that relate to the information that must be supplied at application stage. As drafted, regulation 83 bis applies only after a contract award, which means the LTC and Council would not have this information available when assessing the contract. If this is incorporated into DR7 then we wonder if paragraph 1 would be better relocated to contractor's annual reporting requirement under DR38 to ensure this information is periodically updated. Right now it is also unclear from DR 83 bis when this information must be submitted, which makes it a difficult regulation to enforce — linking it to the annual reporting will help address this issue.
