We have doubts that it would be possible for Inspector to visit any vessel or installations without prior notification of the contractor. Besides that, the vessel should be ready for accommodation of any additional persons.

We believe para. 5(f) set forth two different issues. The first one relates to the deployment of remote monitoring equipment that should be applicable to all contractors and can be deployed during inspections. At the same time we suggest to keep in mind the relevance to include additional regulations on that matter.

The second issue relates to the access to monitoring operations of the Contractor and should be regulated in a new subpara.
