In paragraph 1(a)(i) and 2(a), we propose using the phrase "an ecosystem approach" rather than "the ecosystem-based management approach," as we are not aware of a universally accepted definition of this term, and we further note the terminology we suggest is that used by the draft BBNJ agreement.

In paragraph 1 part (a)(iv) and (c), we support the addition of text specifying the need for consistency with scientific best practices with regards to the formatting of environmental data and information, in order to support the public release of datasets that are interpretable and useable by the Authority.

Also, the phrase, "best scientific practices" should be consistent and not capitalized when the phrase appears in other parts of the draft regulations such as DRs 46 bis, 51, 61, and Annex VIII.
