## **Administrative instruction**

## Staff selection system

The annex regarding "Procedures for classification and reclassification of posts" is amended as follows.

- 1. A new section 5.2 is inserted as follows:
  - 5.2 The Human Resources Officer shall send the request for classification or reclassification to "OneHR" as soon as possible, which shall include:
    - (a) A complete and up-to-date job description of the post in question, using standardized job descriptions, where applicable;
    - (b) An up-to-date organizational chart showing the placement of the post in question and of other posts that may be affected by the classification or reclassification requested;
    - (c) A valid and available post number confirming the existence of a post approved at the appropriate level in the budget, unless the request is submitted for advice prior to a budget submission.
- 2. Existing section 5.2 is renumbered as section 5.3.
- 3. A new section 6.1 is inserted as follows:
  - 6.1. Classification decisions shall become effective as of the first of the month following receipt of a classification request fulfilling the conditions of section 5.2 above. When a classification request is submitted for advice prior to a budgetary submission, the classification shall become effective once the reclassification has been approved in the budget.
- 4. Existing sections 6.1, 6.2 and 6.3 are renumbered as sections 6.2, 6.3 and 6.4.
- 5. Section 6.4 (b) is replaced by the following text:
  - (b) After the recruitment process, if the incumbent satisfactorily meets all qualifying requirements, the incumbent shall be selected and accorded the new grade of the post;
- 6. The present amendment shall take effect on the date of its issuance.
