For more information

- A Bachelor's degree in a relevant discipline (with full transcript) and/or 1-2 years of relevant work experience. No previous knowledge of ISA and law of the sea is required.
- If English is not the applicant's mother tongue or the language of teaching and learning at undergraduate level, applicants must submit with their registration an internationally recognized English language proficiency test. Acceptable tests include International English Language Testing System (IELTS, band 6.0 or above), Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL internet-based test score 80+ and paper-based test score 550+), Cambridge examinations (level CP/C2).
- Complete motivation statements outlining how the programme will further the applicant's career.
- Motivation statement outlining the applicant's background, reason for enrolling and what they hope to gain from the course.
