Subject: Official holidays for 2025 at the International Seabed Authority

The list reflects the practice applicable to all United Nations common system organizations in Kingston, to make mandatory the observance of the two Muslim holidays of Eid al-Fitr and Eid al-Adha. Should staff wish to observe any additional national, local or religious holidays, as has been the practice in past years, they are encouraged, and normally should be allowed by their supervisors, to take annual leave.
- 3. Staff members working at the Office of the Permanent Observer for the International Seabed Authority to the United Nations in New York will observe the official holidays designated by the United Nations for 2025 at United Nations Headquarters.
