- 1. The Area and its resources are the common heritage of humankind. Activities in the Area shall be carried out for the benefit of humankind as a whole. Accordingly, a general provision on the sharing of benefits should be included in Regulation 2.
- 2. Paragraph 5 bis is formulated in accordance with Article 140(2) of the UNCLOS.
- 3. Regarding paragraph 5ter, a timeframe should be set out for formulating rules, regulations, and procedures on the sharing of benefits, in order to ensure that the RRPs be in place at the right time safeguarding the implementation of the principle of the common heritage of humankind.
- 4. The procedure for formulating the RRPs on the sharing of benefits, as contained in Paragraph 5ter, is in line with the mandates of the Assembly and the Council as provided for in Articles 160 and 162 of the UNCLOS.
