Regulation 44 bis

Regional Environmental Management Plans

  - 1. The Council may request the Commission to prepare a Regional Environmental Management Plan for the regional areas where activities in the Area are likely to take place, for consideration and adoption by the Council.
  - 24<sub>k</sub> The Commission shall only consider an application for a Plan of Work if a Regional Environmental Management Plan has been adopted by the Council for the particular area and type of resource concerned [in line with the Council approved procedures and template].

2bis. As a general rule, a Regional Environmental Management Plan for a specific area shall be finalized prior to the expiry of the first exploration contract in that area.

- 32. In the event that an application for a Plan of Work is submitted for an area where no such Regional Environmental Management Plan exists, the drafting of a Regional Environmental Management Plan applicable to the area in concern shall be prioritised and adopted without any undue delay, taking into account Section 2, Article b and c of the Agreement]-prioritized. If such Regional Environmental Management Plan has not been adopted by the Council within 2 years after the submission of an application of a Plan of Work, the Commission shall consider the application for decision without delay, and the Council shall expedite in parallel the formulation of such Regional Environmental Management Plan.
- 3 bis. The Council shall, based on the recommendations of the Commission, adopt the rules, regulations and procedures in relation to the development, establishment and review of Regional Environmental Management Plans.

  - 1. The development of the REMP is the responsibility of the International Seabed Authority rather than the responsibility of the contractors. If the consideration and approval of plans of work were to be delayed due to the lack of REMP, it would undermine the legitimate rights and interests of contractors. Considering that current

REMP is only available in CCZ and no REMP exists in other regions, such inconsistency will create inequity and discrimination among contractors in different regions, which contradicts the provision and spirit of the UNCLOS. Thus, it is necessary to establish a two-year timeframe for the formulation of the REMP from the submission of a plan of work. And for the same rationale, it is suggested to insert paragraph 2 bis to establish a general timeframe for the formulation of the REMP.
