Request for inspection in the event of [harmful effects] to the Marine Environment

[1. In reviewing a contractor's annual report, the Commission may inform the Compliance Committee of a possible non-compliance situation on the contractor's activities. The Compliance Committee shall consider such situation and may recommend, if necessary, to the Council for initiating an inspection.

<u>1bis.</u> In the event of [harmful effects] [] [or risk of harmful effects] to the Marine Environment-[[adjacent]/[potentially affected]] [_coastal State or States][any coastal community] which have reasonable grounds for believing that such harmful effects are caused by activities in the Area, shall notify the [Chief Inspector [and the relevant Contractor] Compliance Committee through the Secretary-General in writing of the grounds upon which such belief is based and request an inspection. [._The notification shall include all relevant evidence, and all documentation supporting the belief that the harmful effects are caused by activities in the Area-].

<u>1ter.</u> Anyone who has reasonable grounds for suspecting that a contractor has violated the Convention, the Exploitation regulations, Exploitation contracts, or caused harmful effects to the marine environment, may request the Compliance Committee through the Secretary-General for inspection in writing.

- 1. It does not need to conduct inspections regularly. Inspection can only be initiated when certain conditions are met.
- 2. Further to the condition indicated in paragraph 1bis, paragraphs 1 and 1ter are two additional conditions for initiating inspections. These three conditions can ensure that inspections be duly initiated whenever necessary.
