## Subject: Official holidays for 2026 at the International Seabed Authority

1. The purpose of the present circular is to inform the staff that the official holidays for 2026 have been designated as follows:

New Year's Day Thursday, 1 January

Ash Wednesday, 18 February

Eid al-Fitr Friday, 20 March
Good Friday Friday, 3 April

Easter Monday, 6 April

Eid al-Adha Wednesday, 27 May

Independence Day Thursday, 6 August

National Heroes' Day Monday, 19 October

Christmas Day Friday, 25 December

Boxing Day Monday, 28 December\*

- 2. This list reflects the practice followed by all United Nations Common System organizations in Kingston, making it mandatory to observe the two Muslim holidays, Eid al-Fitr and Eid al-Adha. Staff wishing to observe additional national, local, or religious holidays, as in previous years, are encouraged to do so and, in general, should be permitted by their supervisors to take annual leave
- 3. Staff at the Office of the Permanent Observer for the International Seabed Authority to the United Nations in New York will observe the official United Nations holidays designated for 2026 at UN Headquarters.
