The Ministry of Foreign Affairs, International Business and Cooperation of the Republic of Suriname presents its compliments to the Secretary-General of the International Seabed Authority (ISA), and with reference to article 83 and article 84 of the United Nations Convention on the Law of the Sea (UNCLOS), has the honour to communicate the following.

The Ministry informs that the Republic of Suriname and the French Republic have agreed on the maritime delimitation regarding the adjacent coast with the overseas territory French Guiana which is laid down in an agreement entitled the "Akkoord inzake Maritieme Afbakening tussen de Regering van de Republiek Suriname en de Regering van de Franse Republiek met de Verklaring tussen Suriname en Frankrijk inzake de samenwerking op maritiem gebied" in the Dutch and French languages.

This Agreement has been signed in Paris on the 8th of November 2017, which entered into force between both countries on the 1st of November 2018.

The Ministry would furthermore deposit a copy of above-mentioned Agreement in the Dutch and French languages as well as the chart of the geographical coordinates, which is attached to this diplomatic note.

The Ministry of Foreign Affairs, International Business and Cooperation of the Republic of Suriname avails itself of this opportunity to renew to the Secretary General of the International Seabed Authority the assurances of its highest consideration.
